

Drone Racing & Flight School with Mr. Mez


Every Monday | 4:00 - 5:30 PM



How to Guide

- 1. Scan the QR code on the previous page and click "Register Today"
- 2. Use the menu or the search bar to find the program(s) you're looking for.
- 3. Click the green () button to review the program description and dates.
- 4. Click "Enroll"
 - a. If you do not have an account, you will be prompted to create one. See instructions at the bottom of this page.
- 5. Click "Select" for the contact you wish to sign up, then click "Save."
- 6. Click the cart icon () in the progress bar and click "Next" to continue.
- 7. If this is your first time registering, complete the following. If you have previously registered, these items should already be complete:
 - a. Complete required fields in the Questionnaire and click "Next".
 - b. Sign all 4 documents under <u>Contracts</u>. Click "Sign" to print your name and add an e-signature, then click "Complete".
- 8. Once all contracts are signed, click "Next" to finalize registration.

HOW TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT

- 1. Click "Create Account."
- 2. Fill in the required information with PARENT information.
- 3. Click "Submit."
- 4. To verify your account, check your email. Open the inbox for the email that you entered on the registration form. You may have to check spam.
- 5. Locate the "Welcome to TGR Labs" message and click the link provided.
- 6. Enter in a password and click "Change Password."

HOW TO ADD A CONTACT

Once you have created an account, you will need to add a contact for each student. Follow the steps below for each student you wish to add.

- 1. Click "Create a New Contact".
- 2. Enter the required STUDENT information.
- 3. Click "Save" and refer to the steps above to register for courses.



Getting to the Lab

If you're taking SEPTA, you can take the **65** or **105** traveling toward or from 69th Street Station. We recommend getting off at the **75th Street bus stop**, near Rose Playground, and walking the path along Lansdowne Avenue.
